# New Pak govt likely to rake up Kashmir issue

Shehbaz Sharif called an emergency meeting of economic experts for the ongoing crisis

The government led by Shehbaz Sharif in Pakistan will establish contacts with friendly countries following the policy of peace and equality, and trade with these states will be enhanced, Express Tribune reported.

"The new government will raise the Kashmir issue on all international forums," Express Tribune reported.

The federal government will work with the Chinese government to expedite the CPEC projects and further expand relations with Afghanistan.

Pakistan will not become a part of any war and will promote peace on international level, PML-N sources said, indicating broad contours of the new federal government's foreign policy.

The new government would maintain relations with the US on the basis of equality with a "clear principle of no do more" and take Parliament into confidence on all important decisions on foreign affairs.

Sources said Shehbaz would formulate guidelines.

## China looks to speed up CPEC projects

**Beijing:** China on Tuesday congratulated Pakistan's new Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and said that besides ramping up ties by "resolutely" backing each other, Beijing looks forward to building a "high quality" \$60 billion China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). "China and Pakistan are all-weather strategic and comprehensive cooperation partners," said Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian.

## Sharif thanks PM Modi

**Islamabad:** Pakistan's newly-appointed Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Tuesday thanked his Indian counterpart Narendra Modi for felicitating him and said his country desires "peaceful and cooperative" ties with India. Sharif, however, emphasised that peaceful settlement of outstanding disputes including Jammu and Kashmir is indispensable. "Let's secure peace and focus on socio-economic development of our people," Sharif tweeted.

## Sharif abolishes two weekly offs in government offices

**Beijing:** Islamabad: Pakistan's newly-elected Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on the first day in office on Tuesday abolished two weekly offs in government offices and also changed their timings, as he attempted to revive the cash-strapped country's economy. Sharif, who was sworn-in as the 23rd prime minister of Pakistan on Monday, reached his office at 8:00 am before the arrival of the staff, most of them reaching at the 10:00 am, which was set as office opening time by the previous Imran Khan government. The Prime Minister changed office timings to 8 am instead of 10:00 am.

## UK 'PARTYGATE' SCANDAL

### PM Johnson, Sunak to be fined

British Prime Minister Boris Johnson and his Chancellor Rishi Sunak will be fined by police over the "partygate" scandal for breaching Covid pandemic rules following allegations of lockdown parties at government offices.

Downing Street on Tuesday confirmed that the two senior-most UK government officials had received notification from the Metropolitan Police that they would be given "fixed penalty notices" or a legally binding sanction.

"The Prime Minister and Chancellor have today received notification that the Metropolitan Police intend to issue them with fixed penalty notices," a Downing

Street spokesperson said. Boris Johnson's wife, Carrie Johnson, is also among those notified of such a notice.

"In the interests of transparency, Mrs Johnson can confirm she has been notified that she will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN). She has not yet received any further details about the nature of the FPN," her spokesperson said.

The Opposition Labour Party immediately demanded the resignation of both Johnson and Sunak over the breach of legal rules imposed by the government during the pandemic.

"Boris Johnson and Rishi Sunak have broken the law and repeatedly lied to the British public," said Labour Leader Keir Starmer.

## Google sues puppy scammer

**Washington:** Internet users beware! An alleged puppy fraud scheme has recently come to Google's notice. The tech giant, on Monday, sued a scammer for running a puppy fraud scheme, defrauding vulnerable people, including the elderly, out of thousands of dollars with false promises of purebred puppies, The Verge reported.

In its complaint, Google has stated that the scammer Nche Noel from Cameroon has used Gmail and Google Voice services with dozens of usernames to communicate with the victims.

In one instance, a victim paid Noel \$700 in "electronic gift cards" to purchase a puppy. After sending the gift cards, Noel continued to string along the victim, telling them that the delivery company needed an additional \$1,500.

## Over 10,000 civilians dead: Mayor

**Kyiv:** Six weeks of brutal Russian siege have left more than 10,000 civilians dead in the southern port city of Mariupol and corpses "carpeted through the streets," the mayor of that cut-off city said, as the West warned that a Russian convoy and other troops and weapons were on the move for a suspected planned Russian assault in Ukraine's east.

Speaking by phone on

**Mariupol has been the site of some of the heaviest attacks and civilian suffering**

Monday with The Associated Press, Mariupol Mayor Vadym Boychenko accused Russian forces of having blocked weeks of attempted humanitarian convoys into the city in part to conceal the carnage there from the outside world. Boychenko said the death toll there could surpass 20,000. Boychenko also gave new details of allegations by Ukrainian officials in recent weeks that Russian forces have brought mobile cremation equipment to Mariupol to dispose of the corpses of victims of the siege. Boychenko spoke from outside Mariupol.

## Report of Mariupol chemical attack sparks concern

The US and the UK have said they are looking into reports that chemical weapons have been used by Russian forces attacking the Ukrainian port of Mariupol.

Ukraine's Azov regiment has said three soldiers were injured by "a poisonous substance" in an attack on Monday.

UK Foreign Secretary Liz Truss said officials were working to "urgently" investigate what she called "a callous escalation" of the war.

The Pentagon called the potential use of the weapons "deeply concerning".

Western nations have warned that the use of chemical weapons would mark a dangerous escalation of the conflict and have pledged to take firm action if Russia carries out such attacks.

Ukraine's Deputy Defence Minister Hanna Maliar said the government was investigating the allegations, adding that early assumptions suggested phosphorous ammunition had been used.

On Tuesday, pro-Russian separatist forces in Donetsk



denied carrying out the attack.

The Azov battalion, which has been heavily involved in fighting in Mariupol and has strong ties to the far-right, wrote in a telegram post that Russian forces had dropped "a poisonous substance of unknown origin" during a drone attack at the city's large Azovstal metals plant.

The reported incident, which the BBC cannot independently verify, came hours after a spokesperson for the Moscow-backed Donetsk People's Republic urged Russia to bring in "chemical forces" to the besieged south-eastern city.

The war has been continuing for six weeks.

## Russia destroy foreign supplies of missile systems

**Moscow:** Russia's armed forces have destroyed air defence equipment supplied to Ukraine by a European country, the Russian Defence Ministry has said. "On April 10, high-precision sea-based Kalibr missiles destroyed the equipment of an S-300 anti-aircraft missile division, which was supplied to Kiev by a European country," Russian Defence Ministry Spokesperson Igor Konashenkov told a daily briefing on Monday. The equipment previously hidden in a hangar was destroyed in the eastern Ukrainian city of Dnipro.

## DELHI CLEARS AIR ON RUSSIAN OIL BUY

In a strong response to criticism of India's purchase of Russian oil, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Monday said India's total purchases of Russian oil for one month were less than what Europe does in one afternoon.

Answering a question about India's import of Russian oil, Jaishankar said, "If you're looking at India's energy purchases from Russia, I'd suggest your attention should be on Europe. We buy some energy necessary for our energy security. But I suspect, looking at figures, our purchases for the month would be less than what Europe does in an afternoon."



Over the ongoing war in Ukraine, the minister said that India has made a number of statements that articulate its position on the conflict.

"Briefly what that position state is that we are against the conflict, we are for dialogue and diplomacy, we are for urgent cessation of violence and we are prepared to contribute to these objectives."

Meanwhile, Shiv Sena MP Priyanka Chaturvedi on Tuesday termed External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar's response to a question on India's energy imports as "superb", in a rare praise for the Centre from its once close ally and now a bitter rival.

## FAST NEWS

### Japan, Italy to lift defence ties

**Tokyo:** Japanese Defence Minister Nobuo Kishi said he and his Italian counterpart agreed on Tuesday to step up military cooperation as Japan expands security ties with Europe amid concern about Russia's invasion of Ukraine and its impact on Asia. Kishi told reporters that he and Italian Defence Minister Lorenzo Guerini discussed the possible expansion of joint military drills and development of defence technology. Guerini, who is visiting Tokyo, especially expressed interest in possible Italian participation in Japan's F-X next generation fighter jet, Kishi said, declining to elaborate. It would be Japan's first domestically developed fighter jet in 40 years.

### Two new Omicron sub-variants detected

**Johannesburg:** South African scientists have detected two new sublineages of the Omicron variant of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes Covid. According to Tulio de Oliveira, Director of the Centre for Epidemic Response & Innovation, South Africa, the lineages have been named BA.4 and BA.5. However, he said, the detection was no cause for alarm and it was too early to assess the impact of this emergence on the virus' epidemiology. In a series of tweets, de Oliveira said the lineages have not caused a spike in infections in South Africa and have been found in samples from a number of countries.

### Indonesia passes bill on sexual violence

**Jakarta:** Indonesia's House of Representatives on Tuesday passed a long-awaited sexual violence bill, which had been languishing in the country for nearly a decade. The bill, which was initially proposed in 2012, is aimed to provide a distinct legal framework that acknowledges sexual violence as a criminal act punishable by law, and gives protection to victims. The House approved the bill after a majority of lawmakers backed it. Xinhua news agency reported. "The ratification of the sexual violence bill into law is a gift for all Indonesian women," said House Speaker Puan Maharani, who chaired the plenary session to ratify the bill.

### Japan: Honda outlines strategy on EVs

**Tokyo:** Honda is investing 5 trillion yen (\$40 billion) over the next decade in research, especially to realize a major shift to ecological electric vehicles, the Japanese automaker said Tuesday. The products and services in the works will account for more than half of its 8 trillion yen (\$64 billion) research and development budget in that time and will be tailored for each major market, the US, China and Japan. Efforts in North America will focus on the collaboration with General Motors Co., under which Honda Motor Co. is jointly developing two midsize to large EV models, set for sale in 2024.

### Iran summons Afghan envoy

**Tehran:** Iran on Tuesday summoned Afghanistan's envoy in Tehran over attacks the previous day on Iranian diplomatic missions in the neighbouring country, state media in Iran reported. According to the reports, Iran's foreign ministry summoned the Afghan chargé d'affaires in protest over Monday's attacks on the Iranian Embassy in Kabul and the Iranian Consulate in Herat, where protests had turned aggressive. In Herat, angry Afghan protesters pelted the consulate with rocks. The ministry demanded that Afghanistan's new Taliban rulers provide the missions with full security and said they stopped working until further notice. On Monday, ministry spokesman Saeed Khatibzadeh said more needed to be done by the Taliban to ensure security to Iranian missions. Later on Tuesday, Iran said the missions had reopened.

## Shanghai eases 2-week shutdown

Some residents of Shanghai were allowed out of their homes on Tuesday as the city of 25 million eased a two-week-old shutdown Tuesday after videos posted online showed what was said to be people who ran out of food breaking into a supermarket and shouting appeals for help.

The number of people who were allowed out wasn't immediately clear. The government said some markets and pharmacies also would reopen.

The abrupt closure of most businesses and orders to

stay home left the public fuming about a lack of access to food and medicine. People who test positive for the virus have been forced into sprawling temporary quarantine facilities criticized by some as crowded and unsanitary.

Meanwhile, Washington set up a possible new clash with Beijing by announcing all "non-emergency US government employees" would be withdrawn from its Shanghai Consulate while consular officers would stay. The Chinese government complained last week after the State Department said diplomats and their families could leave if they wanted.

The unusual severity of Shanghai's shutdown starting March 28 appeared to be driven as much by politics as by public health concerns.

The struggle in China's richest city is an embarrassment during a politically sensitive year when President Xi Jinping is expected to try to break with tradition and award himself a third five-year term as leader of the ruling Communist Party.

China's case numbers are relatively low, but the ruling party is enforcing a "zero-tolerance" strategy that has suspended access to major cities to isolate every infected person. China reported 24,659 new cases on Monday.

## Global Covid caseload tops 499.8 mn

**Washington:** The global coronavirus caseload has topped 499.8 million, while the deaths have surged to more than 6.18 million and vaccinations to over 11.11 billion, according to Johns Hopkins University. In its latest update on Tuesday morning, the University's Center for Systems Science and Engineering (CSSE) revealed that the current global caseload and the death toll stood at 499,748,065 and 6,181,560 respectively, while the total number of vaccine doses administered has increased to 11,110,770,965.

## 'Suspected killer of Indian student in Canada arrested'

The Toronto Police on Tuesday announced that a man, who is believed to have shot and killed 21-year-old Indian student Kartik Vasudev in Canada, has been arrested.

The victim, who hailed from Ghaziabad in Uttar

Pradesh, had moved to Canada in January to pursue higher education, according to his family.

Kartik was shot on Thursday evening at the Glen Road entrance to Sherbourne TTC station in St James Town. He was rushed to a hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.
